



What is an GazettEdition?

An electronic edition is an EXACT REPLICA of The Gazette. Students can log onto any computer with internet access and flip through pages and skim headlines, just as they would with the traditional newspaper.

What are the benefits of subscribing to GazettEdition?

Readers can view all the text, photos, and advertisements exactly as they are printed in the daily paper, plus have the option to change the screen layout, move easily through pages and sections, and save and send articles with a click of a button.

Is there a cost to GazettEdition subscriptions?

The Gazette-NIE subscriptions are provided to schools at no cost.

May I view a demo before I subscribe to GazettEdition?

Yes, Just go to the NIE home page and click on "Demo" under the log-in box.

How does GazettEdition subscription work?

Order forms are available on the NIE home page. Once you have filled out your order you will receive an e-mail with your USER ID and password.

Do I have to use the same USER ID number assigned by NIE, or may I change it to make it easier for me to remember?

School subscribers must use the USER ID and Password assigned to them.

Do students have to use the same computer(s) everyday?

No. Students can log on from one computer at school and one from home. It does not have to be the same computer. However, it can not be more than 2 on any given day.

How soon will my GazettEdition start?

Within two days. Three days for weekend registration.

Where do I go to log-in?

The page link for signing into your daily GazettEdition is on the NIE Home page.

What if I can not log-in or have trouble viewing the GazettEdition?

Can I subscribe even if I do not have computers in my classroom?

Yes. You can use a smartboard or LCD projector or computer lab. Students may also use their home computers.
